- Request from incarcerated person (letter or e-message)
  - Survey sent, completed & returned to AI
  - Added to Waiting List (WL)
- Request from volunteer adopter (website form)
  - Prepare and send list of 3-5 possible matches
  - Provide contact info for selected adoptee(s)
    - Maximum of 2 to start
