

(Facilities) # Prisoners

County (2,850) 547,000

Houses pre-trial detainees and people with shorter sentences (usually 2 years or less). Jurisdiction of the Sheriff's Office. Facilities typically called:

- Los Angeles County Jail
- Travis County Correctional Complex

State (1,566) 1,042,000

Houses post-conviction prisoners serving sentences of 1-2+ years. Jurisdiction of State law enforcement.

Federal – Bureau of Prisons (102) 208,000

Houses post-conviction prisoners convicted of Federal crimes. Under jurisdiction of Federal Government.

FCI = Federal Correctional Institution – Medium & Low Security

- 63 Facilities (7 house women)

USP = United States Penitentiary – High Security

- 20 Facilities (2 house women)

Private Correctional Institutions (GEO, CCA, MTC)

- 13 Facilities

FPC = Federal Prison Camps – Minimum Security

- 8 Facilities (2 house women)

Administrative Facilities: Special missions, all security levels (except ADX)

Congressionally-mandated quota of 34,000 beds (in 2020)

Juvenile Correctional Facilities (1,510) 36,000

Indian Country jails (82) 2,500

Involuntary Commitment (38 States, State and Federal) 22,000

Prisons in the U.S. Territories & Commonwealths (#?) 10,000

American Samoa, Guam, and the U.S. Virgin Islands, Northern Mariana Islands and Puerto Rico

The U.S. Justice system controls **5.7 million people**, more than half of whom are on probation.
