Thank you for your interest in our organization. Adopt an Inmate is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization dedicated to promoting the value and rehabilitation of people in prison. By connecting them with supportive adopters, our organization amplifies their voices, expands their support systems, and increases the likelihood of successful reentry into society. Through educational programs and community partnerships, we strive to improve the criminal legal system and create a more just and compassionate society.

This service is provided free of charge to both adoptees and adopters. Participants are matched based on common interests, location, age, and other information provided to us by adopters and adoptees.

We began our work in 2013, after a family member was incarcerated, and discovered the challenges of incarcerated people who have few if any positive social connections. Ten years later, we have been in contact with well over 15K incarcerated people in all 50 states. 2,500+ of those have been adopted, with more connections every day.

Enclosed is an application for you to complete and return. Read all the information on this letter and application thoroughly. Mail the completed application (address on reverse) and keep this letter for your records.

We welcome your stories from the inside for our *Letters From Prison* series, as well as artwork (including "welcome" banners, see examples below) to publish on our website. Please do extend this invitation to anyone who might have something to share. We love to get mail but please be patient with response time as we are constantly under an avalanche of requests. A self-addressed stamped envelope is most appreciated if you require a reply.

**NOTE**: We are not a dating service (although we do consider gender preference), nor are we lawyers (do not send us your legal documents). Our intention is to create opportunities for positive social connection and mentorship.
